Dear Junior,

The selection process for the STA Peer Leadership program will begin on **Tuesday**, **February 4**, **2020**. Those juniors who are selected will be enrolled in the peer leadership course for the 2020-2021 school year. The Religion 4/Peer Leadership course focuses on peer relationships by using problem solving skills, group cohesion exercises, role-playing and small group discussion.

Peer Leaders are required to attend a three day workshop in late August/early September, a two day mid-winter workshop in January, Junior Peer Leadership Training and a Peer Leadership Closure Workshop. These activities are a part of the PL class and supersede all extra curricular activities. Dates of these events will be given in advance to allow for notification and schedule changes. Peer Leadership counts as your Religion requirement for senior year. In this course, peer leaders are committed to meet with a peer teacher daily for one class period throughout the year to improve leadership and communication skills and to develop a greater awareness of group process. A textbook, daily journal, periodic tests/quizzes, mid-term and final exams are academic requirements. In the second quarter, peer leaders will begin to co-lead a weekly freshmen discussion group. The STA Peer Leadership program advocates a "substance-free" philosophy and modeling positive behavior to the BGA community.

It requires that all peer leaders commit to this policy by signing a No Use Contract (alcohol, drugs, tobacco, vaping).

Applicants must have a 2.5 or better GPA to be eligible to apply to the Peer Leadership program. Anyone interested in applying must be certain that his or her schedule will allow for this course (see your school counselor, if unsure). If you are interested in participating in this program, please complete an application and return it to the School Counseling Office by Monday, February 10, 2020 by 8 a.m. Applications will not be accepted after this date.

The application process for peer leadership consists of the following steps:

- 1. A completed application, which must be signed by a parent/guardian and student;
- 2. An individual interview with two peer teachers; (sign-up when you return application)
- 3. An observed small group discussion with other applicants.

Lastly, a recommendation sheet listing all applicants will be given to teachers and current peer leaders for confidential feedback.

#### PEER LEADERSHIP SELECTION PROCESS

There are three parts to the selection process. Each part is scored by at least two peer teachers to determine an average for that part. Confidential recommendation sheets are distributed to the faculty and present peer leaders. The final selection is based on the participant's score and recommendations.

#### APPLICATION: PART 1

- Applications can be picked up in the counseling office starting Feb.4th.

  All completed applications must be returned no later than 8:00 am on Feb.

  10th.
- Applications must have a picture and a parent/guardian signature along with completed answers to be considered acceptable.
- Applications are also available on the STA website under Academics/Peer Leadership.
- Applications are judged on clarity of answers, neatness, promptness of submission and the time and effort put into answering the questions.

#### INTERVIEW: PART 2

- Interviews are scheduled on Friday, February 14 (2:15 6:00 pm) & Saturday, February 15 (8 am 2 pm). After turning in an application, participants must sign up for an interview time. The Sign Up sheet is in the counseling office next to the RETURN BOX.
- Interviews are conducted at STA (location will be posted). Participants are asked to be on time and can expect the interview to last about 15 minutes.
- Interviews are conducted by two peer teachers. Questions are focused on aspects of the peer leadership program philosophy.
- Interviewees are judged on punctuality, clarity of answers and verbal and non verbal communication.

#### GROUP OBSERVATION: PART 3

- Groups are scheduled after school, Tuesday, Feb. 18th and Wednesday, Feb. 19th.
- Each participant is assigned a specific date, time and group by Mr. Reilly
- Participants are given a group task and are observed by peer teachers
- Participants are judged on punctuality, communication (listening, eye contact, clarity, respectfulness, etc.) and group skills.
